

Class kit fees cover the cost of supplies used in class and are due after your class has been confirmed by letter. Do not send kit fee with registration fee.

Basketry – “Shoulder Strap Woven Pouch”.

This is a one day class, May 9th only. Participants will weave a one of kind shoulder strap pouch just large enough to hold necessities when you don't want to carry a purse.

Kit Fee: \$35

What to bring to class: A bucket or plastic pan for soaking reeds, an old towel, and small, sharp scissors. Kit will include materials for natural dyed reed, a variety of waxed cotton cords and a form to weave around for size and shaping.

Basketry – “Woven Bowl with Wooden Base”

This is a one day class, May 10th only. Participants will weave a round basket with a wooden base using natural and dyed reed. Spokes will be inserted into a slotted base.

Kit Fee: \$35

What to bring to class: A bucket or plastic pan for soaking reeds, an old towel, and small, sharp scissors. Kit will include a round or oval base, a variety of natural, smoked and dyed reeds, rim material and cord for lashing.

Decoy Carving and Painting

This is a two-day class. Students will learn or sharpen carving skills to carve and paint a life size bufflehead drake decoy. Beginners will learn basic decoy carving and experienced carvers will sharpen skills using knives and rasps, with tupelo wood and acrylic paint. No experience required, just be in the mood for some fun learning!

What to bring to class: An Apron and a small round brush. Kit will include all supplies and tools to use in class.

Embroidery – Beginner

This is a one day class, Tuesday, May 9th. Students will embroider a pillow top or a sachet bag.

Fishing Fly Tying

This is a two day class. Fly tying for warm water game fish. Students will learn proper use of tools and tie wet flies – ants, bream bugs and popping bugs. Students may also learn to make earrings out of fly-tying material if desired.

Jewelry Christmas Tree

This is a one day class, Tuesday May 9th. Students will use their own jewelry (new, antique or reclaimed and attach it to a velvet background. It can then be framed (frame not included and displayed.

Painting in Acrylic

This is two, one-day classes, you may chose Tuesday or Wednesday. Each student will complete a painting of a landscape or seascape on a 11"x14" canvas.

Painting with Alcohol Ink

This is a one day class on Wednesday. Students will use alcohol ink to paint several small prints suitable for cards, four small coasters and one silk scarf.

Painting with Watercolors
